

Minutes of the Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 10th November, 2015, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

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01.11.15- To note Apologies for Absence

Cllr Anne Hannigan, Cllr Richard Hannigan, Cllr Peter Clark, Cllr M D'Souza

02.11.15 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared a personal interest in any Airport or Aviation issues, as he works in the Aviation Industry; he also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 06.11.15, as he works in the Airport Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.11.15, regarding highway issues on the C137, as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Wells declared a personal interest in any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

03.11.15- To confirm the minutes of the Meeting held on 13th October, 2015

These were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Walton and seconded by Cllr Page.

04.11.15 - Public Participation

05.11.15 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

All items on the agenda

06.11.15 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

The next ACC meeting is scheduled for 26th November.

Cllr Marsden advised that Chris Wild has left the Airport and no figures have been available for noise monitoring since August. He has chased this up.

The Search & Rescue service has carried out over 60 rescues since they moved in on 01.04.15.

Captain Andrew Miller is hoping to be able to attend the next Parish Council meeting.

07.11.15 (a) - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

No incidents reported within the villages, although Cllr Marsden has recently reported lampers in Hendale Wood, but this is on the Lincolnshire Boundary.

08.11.15 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Wells advised the precept has been set and residents who receive Council Tax Reduction will have to pay more Council Tax, from 8% to 23% of their bill.

09.11.15 - (a) To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

Clerk to report to North Lincolnshire Council flooding problems underneath Croxton Railway Bridge and outside Whitegate Cottages. Also report flooding problem on the C137, just past the SAR hangar.

Clerk to obtain list of jobs to be carried out from Cllr Richard Hannigan following the recent site visit. Then write to David Wiles at NLC to confirm.

Clerk to request in the meantime the roadsweeper in both villages and ask that the kerbs are cleared. Drains need unblocking in Kirmington & Croxton, ask if grass be cleared from the path in Croxton.

(b) - Any updates on Melton Ross Bridge repairs

Cllr Gallimore expressed her concerns that the bridge weight limit is not being enforced and the length of time the repair work is taking.

(c) - Any updates on the request to Neil Poole regarding the C137

Clerk read out an update from Cllr Richard Hannigan regarding the work due to be carried out in January on the C137. Cllr Marsden declared a personal interest.

Cllr Marsden has complained to North Lincolnshire Council as a member of the public expressing his concerns on the amount of money being spent on this and concern that the work is being carried in the month of January, where there is likely to be bad weather with the C137 from Kirmington

Crossroads to Grasby Bottom being closed, there will be a small number of residents who may get blocked in and the Staff at the Search & Rescue Unit may not be able to get to work, as there is no de-icing or snow clearance carried out on this road if the weather turns bad and the diversion has to be followed to/from Limber.

The facility appears to be busy with maize, as it is taken by tractor and trailer along the C137. Concerns were raised over the movement of tractors on a Sunday.

13.11.15 -(a) - To discuss progress on the Playing Field and work to date
Cllr Walton advised he will cut the grass 1 more time before Christmas. The Football Club has not contacted Cllr Walton regarding the outstanding invoice, nor any future bookings.

Cllr Marsden will speak to the Airport to see if they are interested in using the Football pitch.

Cllr Page suggested block paving would be a good idea under the picnic table area at the playing field. Cllr Walton has some slabs he could provide at cost. **It was resolved** - to add this item to the agenda for next month. Clerk to obtain cost of alternative paving slabs and Cllr Page to obtain quote for laying them.

(b) - To consider the proposal of a pavilion on the Playing Field

Cllr Wells advised that 2 replacement sets of bushes are required for the large children's swings. **It was resolved** for Clerk to order these from Newby's and get them posted to Cllr Wells to fit.

Cllr Marsden went through the Order of Service with all Councillors who were in agreement with the format.

Cllr Page suggested the War Memorial Stone in the Churchyard needs cleaning. The Councillors felt this is not the Parish Council's responsibility with it being in the Churchyard. Cllr Page will speak to the Church Committee in the first instance and report back.

Cllr Wells provided the poppy wreath and crosses for Remembrance Day.

It was resolved to donate £50 towards the poppy appeal for this. Cllr Wells declared a personal interest in this item.

17.11.15 - To consider marking the occasion of the Disbandment of the 166 on 18.11.15

Cllr Marsden has had no update on this as yet.

It was suggested the Parish Council mark the occasion, by erecting a plaque on the stonework at the bottom of the new flagpole.

Wording to be 'This flagpole was erected by the Parish Council, to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of the disbandment of the 166 Squadron on 18.11.45.'
