Minutes of the Parish Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 7th November, 2017, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

Resolution: The Parish Council agreed Clerk to send Cllr Bridges a Get-Well Card from all members.

02.11.17 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared an interest in item 07.11.17, as he works in the Aviation Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee; Cllr Marsden is Chairman of North Lincolnshire Aviation Heritage Association; Cllr Marsden is Committee Member of the Royal Air Force National Services Association (Lincolnshire Branch); Cllr Marsden also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work.

Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.11.17 regarding any highway issues on the C137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Wells declared an interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.
