Minutes of the Parish Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 4th September, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

01.09.18- To note Apologies for Absence

Cllr Peter Clark, Cllr Richard Hannigan, Cllr Julie Gallimore & Cllr Jack Bridges

02.09.18 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared an interest in item 07.09.18, as he works in the Aviation Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee; Cllr Marsden is Chairman of North Lincolnshire Aviation Heritage Association; Cllr Marsden is Committee Member of the Royal Air Force National Services Association (Lincolnshire Branch); Cllr Marsden also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work.

Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.09.18 regarding any highway issues on the C137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Wells declared a personal interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council and The Poppy Appeal as he is a Representative.

03.09.18 - To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 3rd July 2018

The Parish Council considered the minutes dated 03.07.2018.

Resolution: - The Parish Council agreed the minutes were a true and accurate record and these were duly approved and signed.

04.09.18 - Public Participation

None.

05.09.18 - To receive the Chairman's Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

All items are on the agenda.

06.09.18 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee and Noise Monitoring

No further ACC meeting held.

July noise monitoring figures have been reviewed and are all within Government guidelines.

07.09.18- (a) - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

Cllr David Wells chaired the latest NATS meeting. Cllr Marsden attended the latest meeting and asked for clarification if Wildlife & Country Crime incidents are included within the crime figures. He is awaiting confirmation from the Police. Cllr Marsden raised concerns of the number of HGV's which continue to break the weight limit.

(b) - Any updates on the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme

Cllr Kinnell distributed a comprehensive report by the new Neighbourhood Co-Ordinator, Julie Sowerby. This will be included within the village newsletter.

Resolution - Cllr Kinnell agreed to thank Julie for the report on behalf of the Parish Council.

Cllr Kinnell raised concerns regarding the foul smells in the village recently. Local residents have reported them direct to NLC. The Parish Council has also followed up residents' concerns with NLC. Cllr Wells advised if the problem occurs again for residents to contact him with details.

08.09.18 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Wells reminded residents to keep reporting any issues with roads and potholes to NLC.

Clerk read out email from Cllr Richard Hannigan reminding of the Public Health event on 10.10.18 at Kirmington Bowls Club at 7pm. Clerk has advertised the event on the PC website and booked the Bowls Club.

09.09.18 - (a)To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

Cllr Marsden commented how well behaved the Motorcyclists were travelling to Cadwell this year to the Super Bike Event.

Cllr Green advised of a deep hole in the road at Post Office Lane. Cllr Wells agreed to report.

Clerk read out email from the Brocklesby Estate with concerns regarding several properties in Croxton. **Resolution - Cllr Wheeler has agreed to speak**

with the residents of the properties concerned regarding keeping their properties in order and remind them of the Best Kept Village competition the villages enter each year.

Concerns raised of speeding vehicles in the village of Kirmington. Clerk to request golden rivers from Roy Hindmarsh at NLC.

10.09.18 - To receive planning decisions made by North Lincolnshire Council and consider any planning applications received where comments have to be submitted before the next meeting

PA2017/2017 - Mr. George Wise, Brocklesby Estate, outline planning permission granted for a residential development of 7 dwellings with all matters reserved for subsequent approval on land rear of Kirmington Primary School, Main Street, Kirmington - Noted.

PA2018/1043 - Mrs. C Humble, Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, full planning permission granted to erect a 7-metre-high flagpole at War Memorial, High Street, Kirmington - Noted.
