Neighbourhood Watch Activity for the Month of March:

Neighbourhood Watch: Jules is proposing to set up a Whats App Group with all members of Neighbourhood Watch. Whats App is a much more immediate and private way of communicating rather than email/Facebook, it will be strictly limited to those who are just members of Neighbourhood Watch. This Whats App Group will be used for communicating reporting sightings etc, not for general conversations. Jules will be contacting all those who are currently members to help set this up. - **Reporting Suspicious Persons**

Jules feels that there is a very delicate balance between making people aware of things going on crimewise within the area and what is wanted by the Village. Eg. Jules put out an awareness report issued by Caistor Police on the village Facebook site, as she does regularly. It was later reported on the Facebook Site that a young man went for an interview in the village and had a bit of time before it took place, so he walked around the village looking at the memorial site etc. He was subsequently reported by a Villager as suspicious to the Police, the person reporting stated that they were from the Village Neighbourhood Watch (I was not made aware of anything). The police visited the young man later and suspect it was quite upsetting for the individual. The villagers were not happy on the Facebook site that this young man had been reported and for the waste of police time.
