



Nhs Phone Scams

Afternoon all,

We are receiving reports regarding scam phone calls, stating they are from the NHS.

THEY SAID THAT SOMEONE HAS INTERCEPTING THEIR NHS NUMBER AND IF SHE DIDN'T RESPOND AND PRESS 1 THEN SHE WOULD BE ARRESTED.

If you receive a call like this, (Take five to stop fraud), hang up on the call and contact your surgery or the NHS on a number you known and trust.

If you have any concerns regarding this you can contact the NHS or the Police on numbers you known and have used in the past. Never use numbers the call has provide. Please contact them before you pass any information, if it is a genuine call they will not mind you checking them out.

Please remember the Police will not collect money or cards from your address, ask you for a PIN number and never ask you to transfer money out of your account.
