Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on **Tuesday 2nd February, 2021**, at 7:30pm via the Zoom portal.

01.02.21 - To note Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr S Vickers & Cllr T Walton.

02.02.21- Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr T Marsden declared an interest on item 10.02.21 regarding any highway issues on the C137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr D Wells declared a personal interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council as he is a Representative.

Cllr R Hannigan advised that NLC cannot offer a grant to Croxton Church to replace the fencing. However; an environmental grant may be available if they were to replace the fencing with a hedge. Clerk to contact resident to advise to contact Cllr R Hannigan.

Cllr P Clark advised that NLC are looking into hosting NATS Zoom meetings.
