Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on **Tuesday 2nd March, 2021**, at 7:30pm via the Zoom portal.

01.03.21 - To note Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr P Clark.

02.03.21- Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr T Marsden declared an interest on item 10.03.21 regarding any highway issues on the C137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr D Wells declared a personal interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council as he is a Representative.

03.03.21- To consider any applications received for Co-Option onto the Parish Council

04.03.21- To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 2nd February 2021

The Parish Council considered the minutes dated 02.02.2021.

Resolution - The Parish Council confirmed the minutes dated 02.02.2021 were a true and accurate record.

09.03.21- To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr R Hannigan report: -

- NLC have set their budget at 3.8% increase, which is the lowest increase in the Lincolnshire and Humber region.

- At the latest Town & Parish Council Liaison meeting it was suggested each Parish Council publish a Parish Plan. Further details to be explored at the next NLC meeting.

- NLC Environmental Grant may be available for an Electrical Vehicle charging point in the village. To be added to the next Parish Council meeting agenda.

10.03.21 (a) - To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

Cllr R Hannigan advised the Croxton Road work is now complete.

Cllr D Wells advised speeding issues have been reported on social media re the C137.

Resolution - The Parish Council agreed for the Clerk to request NLC install the 'golden rivers' on the C137, south of the High Street junction.

(b) - To consider the request for an additional dog waste bin at Habrough Lane

The Parish Council considered the request.

Resolution - The Parish Council agreed to purchase 1 additional dog waste bin/dual purpose bin near to the concrete pad halfway down Habrough Lane and request NLC to empty 2 weekly.
